Q: Do I need a planning permit?

A: Not all projects need a planning permit.

There are generally two types of permits required when building or altering your home. Building permits are a system of control for the construction or alteration of a building and, in most instances, are required. Planning permits, specifically for alterations and extensions, are generally only required when there is a planning overlay. The most common overlay's being heritage, and significant landscaping. We typically find that 1 in every 8 projects require planning.
